

Current Event assignments are due EVERY Friday!

This assignment counts as 15 points. There are NO make-ups or partial credit available. This assignment must be turned in upon entering the assigned period, every Friday, for credit. If absent, it is due the first day back.

Articles must be:

- Minimum of 10 sentences long.
- NOT about the USA, must be about another country or taken place in a different part of the world.
- Sources that are good - Dogonews, Yahoo News, CNN.com, BBC etc.
- Article needs to be published within the past 4 weeks.
- MUST have a copy of the article attached to the current events sheet we provide.
- Printers/Newspapers are available at school if getting an article is an issue.

Current events assignment requirements:

- Students receive a current event sheet every Thursday, they are also always available in the classroom.
- Grammar counts! Capitalization, punctuation are a must. Names of articles, people, places and things are CAPITALIZED. Every sentence begins with a capital and ends with a period, or some sort of punctuation.
- The evidence can be written exactly as found in article, with quotes.
- The summary must be in student's own words, and not copied from article.
- The summary must be a MINIMUM of 5 sentences, more is expected in order to be a considered thorough.
- We must be able to read the student's handwriting. Students are welcome to type it out and staple it to current events sheet.
- Don't forget to highlight map with where the event took place. The map is on the back of current events sheet.

These make or break a student's Global 9 grade. It is imperative that students complete this task in order to be successful in this course.
