- Read to and with your child every day!!!

 - 3. Look at the pictures.
 - 4. Start the word and see if it "pops" into your head.
 - 5. Make a good guess
- Talk about books!

Accelerated Reader

- Students are expected to take AR tests on every book they read. Encourage accuracy.
- Parents should NOT help with the tests. Students should read and answer the questions on their own.
- They may take tests on books read to them. Click the appropriate selection before taking the test.

Homework
