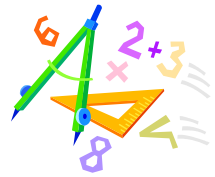
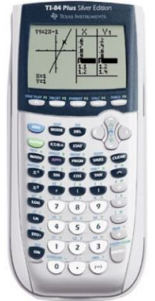


Welcome to the 2020-2021 school year!



Materials:

- ✓ 3-ring binder-at home to save packets

It is **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED** that you purchase your own graphing calculator. You must bring a calculator to class daily.



Hybrid Model:

- ✓ I will be using most In-Person class time to work with you on practicing concepts that you have learned on your Remote Days. Most new concepts will be introduced to you in video lessons. It is **EXTREMELY** important that you watch the video lessons on your remote days. Every lesson builds on the previous day's lesson, making it difficult for you to miss a lesson and still understand all that is being taught.

Information on Algebra 1 Regents Examination:

- ✓ The New York State Algebra 1 Regents Examination is the mathematics exam that **ALL STUDENTS IN NEW YORK STATE MUST PASS IN ORDER TO GRADUATE FROM HIGH SCHOOL**. As of this printing, New York State is still planning on conducting Regents Exams. You will take your exam in June.
*** You will also be (tentatively) taking an Algebra Midterm in January during the week of 1/26-1/29, in preparation for this Regents exam. More information on the Midterm will follow.

Parent Portal on School Tool:

- ✓ I will be updating the Parent Portal on a weekly basis. Please check often so you are aware of your overall average and any missing homework assignments.

Academic Dishonesty:

- ✓ If a student is involved in academic dishonesty (cheating, plagiarism, etc.), a zero will be given for that assignment. No make up assignment will be provided, and if there is an opportunity to drop a grade during the marking period, the above-mentioned grade will not be dropped. The next lowest grade will be dropped. Grading:

Tests	40%
Quizzes	30%
Homework Sets/Classwork	30%

Tests: Tests will be given at the end of each unit. Tests will be designed to model the Algebra 1 Examination, including “multiple choice” and “show your work” questions. All tests are cumulative, meaning they cover material from the entire school year.

Homework Sets: These homework assignments will be given weekly. Homework sets will be graded and the grade on a homework set is final.

In-Person Quizzes: Quizzes will be given periodically throughout each unit. At the end of each marking period, the lowest quiz grade will be dropped. You do NOT need to make up quizzes if you are absent. You will receive a copy of the quiz for studying purposes but you will not need to make it up. Missed quizzes are not factored into your grade.

Google Classroom Quizzes: These will consist of short 10-question quizzes that you will complete in Google Classroom once per week. You may use your notes when taking these mini-quizzes.

Google Classroom:

Google Classroom will be used this year for announcements, video lessons, note packets, homework assignments, and other class materials. You will be provided a daily to-do list that you can follow, both on in-person days and remote days. Additionally, in the event that full distance learning must be implemented at any point in the school year, Google Classroom will be our primary source of communication. It is important that you add Algebra class into your Google Classroom as soon as possible.
